The **Winnebago Conflict Resolution Center** will also highlight other members of the volunteer corps and staff during the training.

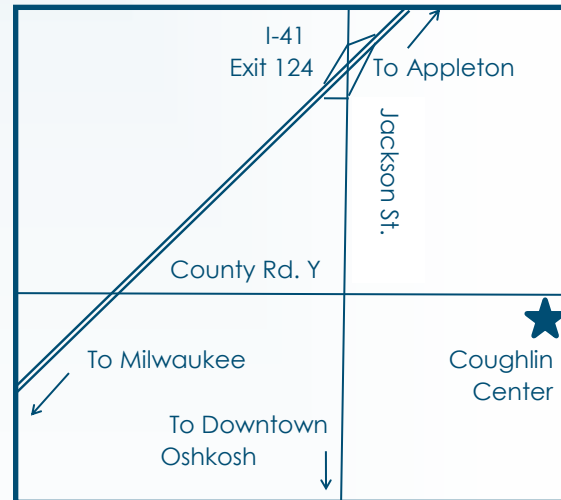

Professional Use: This training is especially valuable to anyone (business people, attorneys, HR, social workers, and more) who deals with clients, employees, and/or family conflicts and wants more tools for handling these conflicts. The Winnebago Conflict Resolution Center is recognized by SHRM to offer Professional Development Credits (PDCs) for SHRM-CP® or SHRM-SCP®. CLE credits have been approved for attorneys (other CE credits may be available). The fee for these five days/forty hours of instruction is only \$825. (There is also an early-bird discount available if registered before May 15, 2022!) Also included is the opportunity to observe eight hours of WCRC/FdLCRC mediations and to co-mediate another eight hours of actual mediations with experienced WCRC mediators.

Volunteers: Volunteer opportunities are available! The WCRC/FdLCRC will underwrite a significant portion of your training fee if you agree to our volunteer terms and are approved by the WCRC/FdLCRC Board of Directors as a volunteer. Volunteers must commit to serving for a minimum of five hours a month for one year for the WCRC on Thursday mornings or for the FdLCRC on Monday mornings (approx. 4 days per month) for our small claims mediations. The training fee for volunteers is only \$150. (There is also an early-bird discount available if registered before May 15, 2022!)

Serving as a volunteer mediator for the WCRC/FdLCRC presents a remarkable opportunity to give back on the front lines. WCRC/FdLCRC mediators work directly with disputants on over 750 cases annually from small claims to the largest civil actions, from conflicts regarding families to restraining orders, and more.

Cancellation Policy: If you must cancel your registration and do so at least one week prior to the start of the training, you will only be charged an administrative fee of \$75. If you are a confirmed registrant and cancel less than one week prior to the start of the training, we cannot provide a refund of your registration. Registrations are transferrable.
